DRIVER'S BRIEF

- All drivers must register 0.00000 on Pascagoula Police Department breathalyzer NO EXCEPTIONS.
- ALL entries must enter the staging area at Magnolia Street and Watts Avenue (see Parade Map). You will return to the same space and pull off the roadway at parade conclusion.
- All entries must be parked by 7 pm.
- Be available at your vehicle from the time it is parked until the parade starts moving at 7:30 pm
- Parade will roll at a continuous speed (less than 2 miles per hour) and last 120 minutes. Please keep spacing consistent. Problems with spacing (due to stopping for anything other than a safety reason) may result in entry being pulled from parade or disqualification for next year's parade.
- Do NOT litter. Remove all trash from staging area or use dumpsters provided. Please do not leave trash/boxes on the road or curbside.
- No inappropriate music or inappropriate behavior.
- No one under the age of 18 may participate in the parade on foot unless part of a military/school marching band.
- No riders in the bed of pickup trucks.
- Drivers should not throw anything from a vehicle that is pulling a float.
- All entries MUST include lights as part of their decoration with a St. Patrick's Day/Irish theme.

Failure to abide by these instructions may result in entry being pulled from parade.
